APPLICABLE BLM STIPULATIONS

1. High Country Watershed – applicable stipulations from the Price Management Framework Plan
 - a. In order to minimize watershed damage, exploration, drilling, and other development activity will be allowed only during the period from April 30 to November 1. This limitation does not apply to maintenance and operation of producing wells. Exceptions to this limitation in any year may be specifically authorized in writing by the Authorized Officer of the Bureau of Land Management.
 - b. Occupancy or other surface disturbance will not be allowed within 330 feet of the centerline or within the 100-year recurrence interval floodplain of the perennial stream (insert name). This distance may be modified when specifically approved in writing by the Authorized Officer of the Bureau of Land Management.
 - c. Occupancy or other surface disturbance will not be allowed within 660 feet of springs, whether flowing or not. This distance may be modified when specifically approved in writing by the Authorized Officer of the Bureau of Land Management.
2. In order to control dust from vehicular traffic, access roads will be watered when dust plumes from passing vehicles exceed 200 feet in length.
3. Wildlife Seasonal Stipulations
 - a. Big game high priority and critical winter range will preclude drilling and other surface disturbing activities between November 1 and May 15, unless a seasonal exception is requested and approved by the BLM.
 - b. An occupied raptor nest (occupied one or more of the preceding three years) will preclude drilling, other surface disturbing activity, and occupancy for area within 0.5 mi of the nest between February 1 and July 15, unless a seasonal exceptions is requested and approved by the BLM.
 - c. Mexican spotted owl critical habitat will preclude drilling, other surface disturbing activity, and occupancy between March 1 and August 25, unless a seasonal exception is requested and granted by the BLM.
 - d. Presence of sage grouse nesting habitat (suitable habitat within 2.0 mi of an active lek) during the breeding and nesting season of March 1 to June 15, unless an exception is requested and approved by the BLM.
